## **2** FIRST LIGHT PAVILION



**6** STAR PAVILION



The **Star Pavilion** houses our **Wolfson Auditorium** for school group sessions, talks and special events.









Exit via the **Planet Pavilion** and see our popular **Clockwork Orrery**, a mechanical model of the solar system. It's also where you'll find our **Gift Shop** and **Planet Café**. Please note that the Planet Café is open at weekends only.

## **OUTDOORS**

Explore over 35 acres of beautiful grounds and **Arboretum**. You'll find plenty of picnic areas around the site including our **Comet Lodge**, a cosy indoor picnic space complete with wood burner.

You can also stroll along our **Exhibition** and **Telescope Pathways**, and don't miss our outdoor exhibits including the ever-popular **Whispering Dishes**.

Please remember that we share this site with an abundance of wildlife and carefully manage the grounds so as to cause minimal disturbance. This is why you'll see wildflower planting, regenerative works, and large sections of grass left unmown. Our grounds also include a number of open ponds. We ask you therefore to be aware of the dangers of open water, and of ice during colder spells. Ponds are not for play and we kindly ask that children are supervised at all times.
