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General movement around the site	Slips, trips, falls	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learners sit on seats for the presenter led activities When learners are allowed to move around the premises they are told to do so carefully; only walking, never running If learners have personal items with them, such as coats, bags, etc., they are instructed to stow them clear of any thoroughfares Duty Managers carry out daily site-wide checks to remove any trip hazards from pathways and ensure exhibits are in a good state of repair Ensure flooring is kept mopped and appropriate signage is set out during wet weather, particularly FLP foyer 	LOW	A
Child protection	Child protection issues	Learners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All presenters DBS checked Learners always supervised in teaching space by presenter and/or group leaders Children should not be left alone with a single adult 	LOW	A
